Classes

Class 1 Lot 1-

Vegetable Plate

- Submit a plate of 5 vegetables. Contestant's name must not appear on the plate.
- Can be any 5 vegetables, the vegetables can be the same but we prefer to have 5 different vegetables
- Plate should not be glass
- Vegetables will be judged on overall appearance and variety of vegetables present

Class 2 Lot 1 -

Woodworking

- Example: birdhouse, toy, wall hanging, etc.
- Item must be able to stand on its own
- No name should be present on the woodwork item
- Please keep item relatively small to where it can fit on a tabletop

Class 3 Lot 1 -

Flower arrangement

- Any size arrangement will be accepted.
- Vase or container must be able to stand alone.
- Flowers must be fresh flowers. Plastic flowers or fake flowers will not be accepted.
- Make sure arrangement has enough water in its container to support the flowers throughout the entire market.
- Arrangement will be judged on variety of flowers, greenery used, creativity, and overall appearance.

Registration and drop off will begin at 8:30am Saturday, August 3 at the 4-H Tent. Please have arrangement turned in by 9:00am, judging will begin at 9am. All late entries will be disqualified

Class 4 Lot 1 -

Corn plate

- Must have at least 3 ears of corn.
- Name should not be anywhere on the plate.
- Plate should not be glass.

Class 5 Lot 1 -

Cupcake Decorating Contest

- Plate of three decorated cupcakes.
- Each cupcake must be decorated. The cupcakes may all be decorated the same or each one may be decorated differently following the theme of your cupcakes.
- Cupcakes will be judged on overall appearance, creativity of the decorating and presentation.

Class 6 Lot 1 -

Sewing

- One entry per category.
- Categories: Clothing, Accessories, Miscellaneous.

Class 6 Lot 2 -

Knitting and Crochet

- One entry per category
- Categories: Clothing, Accessories, Miscellaneous.

Class 7 -

Biggest of Best contest

- Youth can enter multiple times but can only submit one entry per lot/category
- We will have separate contest for the following:

Lot 1: Watermelon Lot 2: Potato Lot 3: Tomato Lot 4: Squash/Zucchini

- You are responsible for placing your produce in the appropriate spot assigned
- Do not write your name on your produce, we will have a card for you to fill out upon arrival
- Weigh in will take place at approximately 10:30 am on Stage, please be around the stage area to lift your produce and help others if need be
- Produce will be judged on weight.
- For a tie breaker we will use measuring tape to measure its size -we will have a scale to weigh it on and measuring tape to get its measurements.

Registration will begin at 9:30 am on Saturday, August 3rd and all entries must be registered at the 4-H tent by 10:00 am. All late entries will be disqualified

CLASS 8 Lot 1-

Corn cooking dish

- Get creative in the kitchen with produce from your garden or the Farmers Market.
- Must include recipe to the dish
- Dish must contain corn and at least one other item from the garden/farmers market
- Will be judged on overall taste and appearance, and that the entry has corn and at least one item from the garden/farmers market
- Please pack your dish properly to keep it at desired temperature for judging.

Registration and drop off will begin at 8:30am Saturday, August 3 at the 4-H Tent. Please have dish turned in before 9:00am, judging will begin at 9am. All late entries will be disqualified

General Rules for Entries:
