## Union County Health Department Expands Vaccine Eligibility and Offers Extended Hours to Increase Access to COVID-19 Vaccination

Maynardville, Tenn. – The Union County Health Department is expanding vaccine eligibility and offering extended hours to increase access to COVID-19 vaccination in the community.

Union County is now vaccinating all residents 16 and older. The Union County Health Department offers COVID-19 vaccination by appointment. To book your appointment, visit <u>Vaccinate.tn.gov</u> and click the blue "Proceed to COVID-19 questionnaire" button at the bottom of the page to start your registration. If you need help scheduling your vaccination, please call 866-442-5301.

The Pfizer vaccine is currently the only COVID-19 vaccine approved for use in individuals 16 and older. Individuals 16 and older may call 866-442-5301 or visit <u>vaccinefinder.org</u> to find a site that offers the Pfizer vaccine. You must be 18 or older to receive the Moderna vaccine.

Beginning March 23, 2021, the Union County Health Department COVID-19 vaccination site began providing extended vaccination hours weekly on Tuesday's 7 a.m. -7 p.m.

"We're eager to offer these additional opportunities for people to receive their COVID-19 vaccinations in a way that works more conveniently with their schedules," said Union County Health Director, Garnet Southerland. "The more people in Union County who choose to get their vaccinations, the sooner our community can return to normal day-to-day activities."

The Union County Health Department reminds all Union County residents that in addition to vaccination, wearing a face mask, maintaining social distance and getting tested when exposed or sick are critical to controlling the pandemic.
